VHA Medical Center's Emergency Management Requirements:

- Develop and evaluate a Comprehensive Emergency Management Program (CEMP) and an all-hazards plan including WMD, consistent with VHA and VISN guidance. (VHA Handbook 0320.2)
- Provide for emergency management staff training.
- Conduct exercises to enable staff to practice and evaluate the activation, response and resumption of normal operational activities.
- Coordinate with local, county and state emergency management entities, public, private and VISN hospitals to ensure compatibility plans and procedures.
