



## Intelligence Support to Domestic Operations Course

**Course Description:** A uniquely tailored 3-5 day introductory course designed for Joint Forces Headquarters-State (JFHQ-State), Joint Task Force – State (JTF-State), J2s and the staffs involved with planning, supporting or directing intelligence operations. The Intelligence Support to Domestic Operations course provides an interactive and in-depth overview of the roles and responsibilities of the J2 in routine and crisis response operations. The course will review a wide range of topics and issues relative to the traditional duties and responsibilities of the J2 with emphasis on the J2's role in Domestic Operations, focusing on the unique threats most common to the state. Experienced instructors, including former J2's, will review the state's intelligence responsibilities and share best practices and lessons learned. Topics will focus on the J2's role in planning and execution of Domestic Operations in a complex interagency environment. All instruction will include a review of relative service and joint doctrine, regulatory guidance and, where applicable, federal law. Some of the course topics will include; the DSCA interagency operational environment, regulatory requirements, Incident Awareness and Assessment (IAA), Joint Intelligence Preparation of the Operational Environment (JIPOE), and J2 Domestic Operations lessons learned. Tailored Practical Exercises (PE) will provide "hands-on" application opportunities.

**Prerequisites:** Students are encouraged to complete the following on-line FEMA Courses: IS 100.b, 200.b, 700.a & 800.b.

**Target Audience:** Newly assigned JFHQs J2s, J2 staff officers and senior Intel NCOs.

**Course Objectives:** Based on the host command's requirements, the Program of Instruction objectives typically include the following:

1. Understand the role and responsibilities of the J2 in planning for, and execution of Domestic Operations.
2. Describe the application of the JIPOE process in an all hazard domestic environment.
3. Develop an effective Incident Awareness and Assessment plan.
4. Describe the J2s role in supporting the JFHQ-State Joint Operations Center Common Operating Picture.
5. Understand the J2's role and responsibilities for liaison and coordination in the interagency operational environment.
